### ***I. Short-Answer***

A 28-year old woman with an 8-week pregnancy comes to your office to discuss her options regarding an unplanned pregnancy. She has two young children, ages 4 and 7, and her husband recently passed away after a car accident. She is emotionally traumatized and expresses concern about raising another child by herself and carrying a pregnancy in her state of mind.
