It is the department's *expectation* that all residents will receive instruction in all aspects of residency training, including induced abortion as set forth by the Intrinsic Objectives, Intrinsic Procedures, and CORE Procedures outlined by CREOG.

It is the department's *expectation* that residents will perform induced abortions with appropriate faculty supervision.

It is not the department's policy that residents will be *required* to perform procedures that violate their beliefs.

We have developed a mechanism for helping residents who are struggling with the dilemma of whether they hold a moral objection to a particular procedure, or whether they are just disturbed by or uncomfortable with the procedure itself. Exceptions will be based on: OHSU's Healthcare Policy regarding conscientious objection.
